5. Make a poster using holiday photos.



You can help your child to enjoy this topic by:

Sharing a story with your child about their world. For example Maisy goes to the City, Lucy and Tom go to School, Oh the Places you'll Go.

Talking about place names and recognising signs and labels in their environment.

Having a discussion with your child about places they have been to.

Drawing things they have seen and places they have been to. Please remind your child to hold the pencil correctly and ask them lots of questions about what they have drawn!

Practice counting houses, cars, trees, animals, people and anything else when they go out with you.

We also need to practice number recognition. You could do this in lots of fun ways. For example, looking at the numbers on people's front doors on the way to school.
