### Our topic is: **Transport**

#### Our key question is:

How do we travel to places?

#### Things we will be learning about:

- Different types of vehicles.
- How vehicles move.
- Places we have been to in different vehicles.
- Staying safe on the road.

We will be sending out a topic leaf. On this, please write down any key questions related to our topic. These should be questions your child would like answered about the current topic.

Reading books will be sent home and can be changed every Monday.

**Creative homework** from this topic will be to make one of the following:

1. Make a model of a vehicle.
2. Paint a picture of your favourite vehicle.
3. Draw something you have seen/done on a journey.
4. Take photographs during a journey showing what you saw and how you got there.
5. Draw the vehicles you see on your route to school.



#### You can help your child to enjoy this topic by:

Sharing a story with your child about people who help us. For example, Thomas the Tank Engine, Cars, Planes, I wish I was a Pilot, and so on.

Having a discussion with your child about different modes of transport they have used, where they went and why they used that particular vehicle to get there.

Encourage your child to draw pictures of different vehicles they see when they are out. Please remind your child to hold the pencil correctly and ask them lots of questions about their drawings!

Practice counting, maybe count how many of a certain colour car or type of vehicle they see on a journey. Encourage children to say number names in the correct order.

You could also practice number recognition. You could do this in many fun ways. For example, looking at number plates on road vehicles or tickets.
