'Who has influenced our world?'



You can help your child to enjoy this topic by:

- Discussing with your child the world around them and important figures around them.
- Taking your child to visit the Natural History Museum or the British Museum.
- Visiting your local library to research influential people.

By the end of this term your child should be able to:

English:

- To be able to use a capital letter and a full stop.
- To know the features of a narrative.
- To perform poetry as part of a group.



Mathematics:

- To be able to add and subtract numbers to 10.
- Recognising numbers 1-10 in written form.
- To be able to compare numbers using $<$ $>$.



You could help your child by:

- Read to your child daily for 15 minutes pointing the punctuation i.e Capital letters and full stops.
- Introduce your child to poetry and non-fiction text.
- Practice writing the names for numbers 1-10.
- Encourage your child to compare quantities of objects using appropriate language i.e. greater than and less than.

We will be sending home spellings for your child to practice every Friday.
