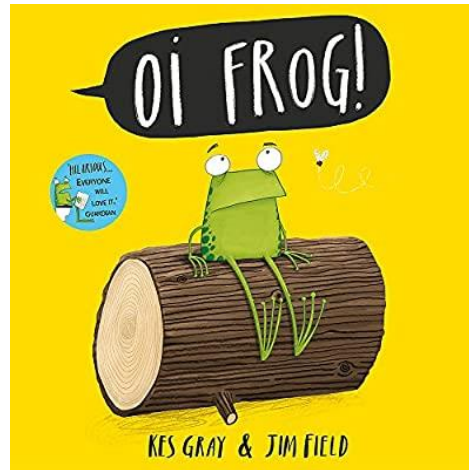

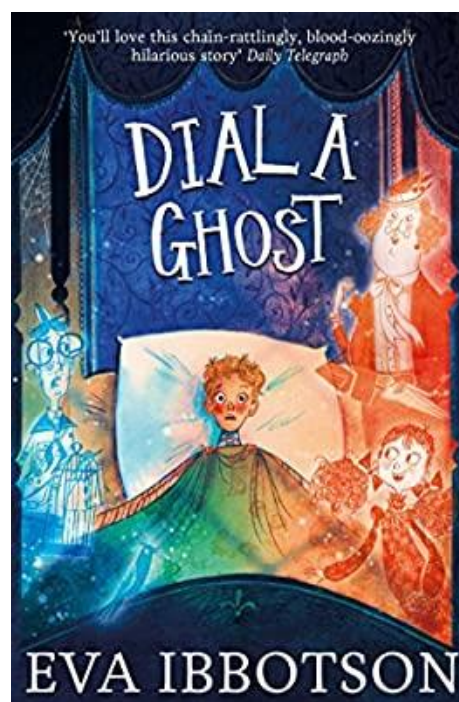

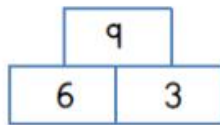

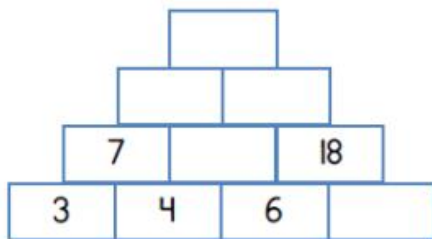
MATHS PROBLEM OF THE WEEK

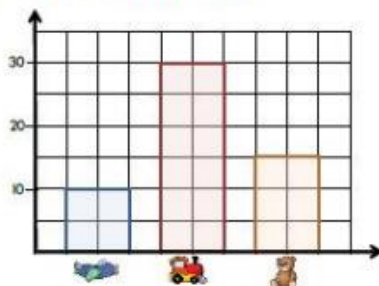


Toy Train £23
